Minerals are substances that form naturally on Earth. They are made up of one or more **elements**, which are the basic building blocks of everything in the universe. **Minerals are solid crystals.** This means they are made of substances whose atoms are arranged in a repeating, orderly pattern. **Minerals are also inorganic:** they are not made of living things. Some **minerals are gemstones** that can be cut and polished for jewelry.

PERIODIC TABLE

The periodic table is used to organize the 118 known elements. Elements make up minerals.

Minerals are also building blocks for rocks. They make up rocks that, in turn, make up our planet.

The Building Blocks of Granite

Granite is a rock that makes up much of Earth's rocky outer layer, the layer of rocks that form the land. Check out how four minerals come together to create granite!

- Quartz:** The second most common mineral in granite. It appears as round, glassy grains. Quartz, along with feldspar, makes granite extremely hard.
- Feldspar:** The most abundant mineral in granite. It appears as white or pink crystals.
- Mica:** This mineral has a pearly luster. Tiny grains of mica make granite sparkle.
- Hornblende:** The mineral that gives granite dark-colored spots.

Defining Rights

In 1927 and the 1940s, members of the religious group Jehovah's Witnesses protested their schools' requirement to say the Pledge of Allegiance. The pledge was against their religion. The Supreme Court ruled in 1943 that public schools cannot force students to salute the flag or say the pledge. In 2000, families sued a school when prayers were said over a loudspeaker at football games. The Supreme Court ruled that the prayers violate freedom of religion.

Looking Ahead

The writers of the Bill of Rights did not imagine today's technology. If your neighbors fly a drone over your yard, are they violating your Fourth Amendment right? If you are accused of a crime, can the police take your cell phone? Do you have to tell the police your passwords, or does the Fifth Amendment protect you? People are still debating these and other questions. Times change, but the Bill of Rights remains.

Timeline of Rights in the Supreme Court

1919

The Supreme Court rules that the government can limit free speech during wartime.

1943

The court decides that students can refuse to salute the flag or say the Pledge of Allegiance.

1982

The court rules that officials cannot remove books from public school libraries just because they disagree with the books' contents.

1985

The court rules that the Fourth Amendment is limited inside schools. School officials have certain rights to search your backpack or locker.

1988

The court determines that public schools can censor school-sponsored newspapers.

2000

The court decides that school-sponsored prayers at football games are unlawful.

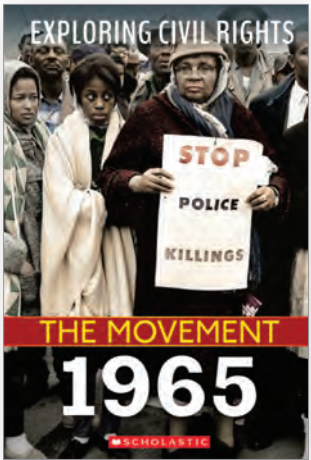

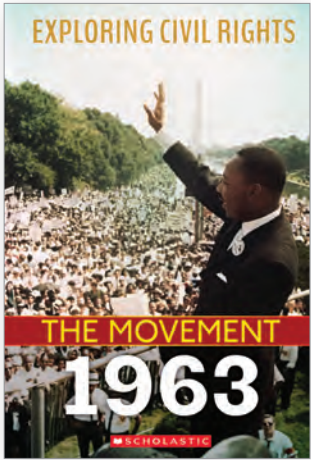

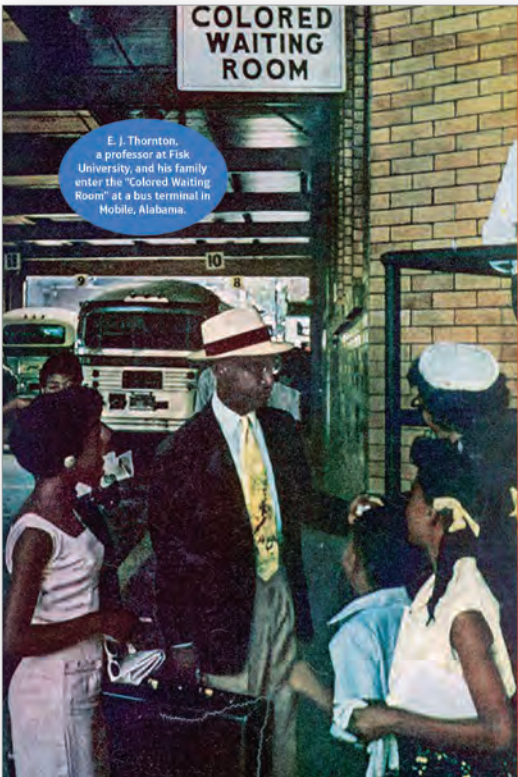

A Challenging Spring

In addition to segregated restaurants and schools, most southern cities had a segregated bus system. In Montgomery, Alabama, Black citizens were allowed to use the same buses as white citizens, but had to follow strict rules.

Black riders were not permitted to sit in the first 10 seats in the front of the bus. These were for white riders only. African Americans were assigned the 10 seats in the back of the bus. In between the two sections were 16 seats. Anyone could sit in this middle section, but Black passengers were required to give up their seat if a white passenger boarded and the first 10 seats were occupied. Black riders were also expected to pay their fare at the front of the bus and then walk back outside to board through the rear door.

Challenging the Rules

On March 2, 1955, high school junior Claudette Colvin boarded a Montgomery City Lines bus. She was riding home on a seat in the middle section. As the bus continued along its route and picked up more passengers, every seat became occupied. The driver, Robert W. Cleere, told four Black women, including Colvin, to give up their seats to the white riders who were now standing in the aisle.

Three of the four Black riders surrendered their seats. Colvin refused. Cleere became enraged and called for the police to deal with the teen. When the officers arrived, they ordered Colvin to get up.

A city bus on the road during the historic 381-day bus boycott in Montgomery, Alabama.

When she refused, they grabbed her wrists and dragged her off the bus. Colvin was forced into a police car, handcuffed, and taken to jail. She was charged with assault, disorderly conduct, and violating Montgomery's segregation laws. Colvin remained in jail until her pastor bailed her out hours later.

News of the arrest spread quickly through Montgomery's African American community. Lawyers from the NAACP believed Colvin's arrest could be the ideal legal test case to challenge Montgomery's segregation laws: Colvin was an
